

COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES

EVERY HORSE ADMITTED ONTO THE GROUNDS MUST FIRST PROVIDE AT THE STABLE GATE A CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE (CVI) ISSUED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF ARRIVAL AT THE TRACK WHICH SHOWS THE VACCINATION RECORD OF EACH HORSE.

- **HORSES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED WITH AN FDA APPROVED MODIFIED LIVE OR KILLED VIRUS VACCINE FOR EHV-1 NOT LESS THAN 14 DAYS PRIOR TO THE ENTRY DATE AT THE RACETRACK AND NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF ENTRY.**
- **HEALTH CERTIFICATES WILL REQUIRE AN ADDED STATEMENT FROM THE EXAMINING VETERINARIAN AS FOLLOWS:**

"THE HORSE(S) LISTED IN THIS HEALTH CERTIFICATE (CVI) HAVE NOT ORIGINATED FROM A PREMISES UNDER A STATE OR FEDERAL QUARANTINE FOR AN INFECTIOUS DISEASE WITHIN THE LAST 30 DAYS."

A HORSE ALSO MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE COGGINS (EIA) TEST ON FILE IN THE RACING OFFICE. THIS APPLIES TO ALL HORSES STABLED AND/OR COMPETING AT WILL ROGERS DOWNS. THE COGGINS **MUST BE AN ORIGINAL** CERTIFICATE DRAWN, PREFERABLY AFTER NOVEMBER 15, 2021.

EQUINE PIROPLASMOSIS

OHRC Rule 35:15-11-53: ALL RACING QUARTER HORSES, PAINTS AND APPALOOSAS ENTERING THE FACILITY SHALL HAVE PROOF OF A NEGATIVE PIROPLASMOSIS TEST (T.EQUI) WITHIN TWELVE (12) MONTHS.

(PONY HORSES EXEMPT)
